
Problems faced and resources required.

Event Type :- Nirmalya Collection

Description :- Collection of religious waste during Ganesh Festival

Venue :- Netaji Nagar Society, Wanawadi, Pune

Date & Duration :- 11th September 2019; 9:30am to 1:30 pm

2. CONCEPTION OF THE PROGRAM

Ganesh Festival is a Hindu festival celebrating the arrival of Ganesha to earth from 'Kailash Parvat' with his mother goddess Parvati/Gauri. The festival is marked with the installation of Ganesha clay idols privately in homes, or publicly on elaborate pandals (temporary stages). Observations include chanting of Vedic hymns and Hindu texts such as, prayers and *vrata*(fasting). Offerings and prasadam from the daily prayers, that are distributed from the pandal to the community, include sweets such as modaka as it is believed to be a favorite of Lord Ganesh. The festival ends on the tenth day after start, when the idol is carried in a public procession with music and group chanting, then immersed in a nearby body of water such as a river or sea

- > Prevent Water Pollution caused due to religious waste during Ganesh Festival
- ➤ Reuse the nirmalva. floral waste. which is largely dumped after offering to the deity in the form of compost and recycle the dry

Like every year this year too Trinity Institute of Management and Research conducted the activity of Nirmalya Collection on 11th September 2019 during the Ganesh Festival. Director Sir, Staff members carried out the activity.

"Nirmalya", the religious waste was collected from "Netaji Nagar Society" Wanawadi, Pune. Students were instructed and collection bags were distributed among the staff and students.

Students were assigned different blocks of the society for collection of religious waste.

After collecting "Nirmalya", it was Dumped into ground for composting. To fasten the process of composting it was mixed with salt.





2. <u>CONCEPT OF THE PROGRAM</u>



India's biggest cleanliness drive – Swachh Bharat Mission has triggered a nationwide flurry of activity to improve sanitation and cleanliness in the country, the ambitious aim of the mega campaign is to achieve 100% open defecation free status by 2019. Till now, more than four crore toilets have been built, five states, around four lakh villages and 203 districts have gained the title of Open defecation free (ODF). On October 2, which is also marked as Rashtriya Swachhta Diwas, this year it is also Swachh Bharat Abhiyan campaign's third anniversary, the sanitation coverage in the country will hit another milestone. The day marks end to another big initiative leading upto October 2 – *Swachhata Hi Seva* which was initiated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in a bid to boost Swachh Bharat mission's effort across the country and celebrate Gandhi Jayanti as Clean Gandhi Jayanti.

TIMR, in complete support of the Rashtriya Swachhta Diwas, celebrated this day by undertaking a cleanliness drive, with support of the local police authorities, at the KJEI Campus and the Bopdev Saswad Ghat.
